
Subject: Minutes of BOS (Mech. Engg. Deptt) meeting.


With reference to subject meeting of members of Board of Studies (Mechanical Engineering Department) held on 28<sup>th</sup> June 2013 at 11:00 AM in the office of Head, Mechanical Engineering, MITS, Gwalior. Following Members were present:


- (i) Prof. Sandeep Jain Associate Professor, SATI Vidisha (External Member)

After review of Scheme & Syllabus, following changes in the syllabus of BE (Mech.), M. Tech. (Production Engineering) and ME (Material Handling) for the session July 2013-June 2014 are proposed:

- (i) It was decided to revise BE (VII & VIII) schemes as per RGPV Grading system and will be implemented for the students who have taken admission w.e.f. July 2010.
- (ii) In the eight semester of BE, it was decided to make Automobile Engineering subject (Now 8222) compulsory in place of previous subject SQC/SPC (Previously 8222).
- (iii) In the BE Eight semester SQC/SPC will be taught as Elective (8224-II) as a theory subject where practical classes will not be conducted.
- (iv) In the final year scheme Project Management subject will inducted as Elective (8224-V) subject in place of previous subject Diagnostic Maintenance as per the suggestions received from Industries. The copy of revised syllabus of above Subjects are attached
- (v) It was decided to make changes in following subjects of BE (Mech.) syllabus:  
**3225: Mechanics of Material-I**  
**5221: Mechanics of Material-II**  
**6221: Machine Design-II**  
**7221: Machine Design-III**  
The copies of revised syllabus of above Subjects are attached.
- (vi) It was decided not to make any changes in M. Tech. (Production Engineering) & ME (Material Handling) Schemes and syllabus as the same was revised in previous BOS meetings.
