


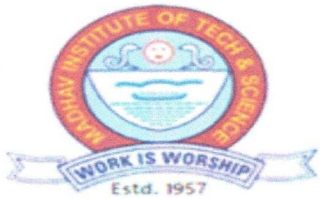

**Important Instructions**

1. Students must regularly check their attendance status on AMS and also with their class coordinators. Those not having attendance as per the ordinance of MITS-DU, will not be allowed to appear in the examinations.
2. All the I year students are expected to register for mandatory Novel Engaging Courses (NEC) in I & II semester and Skill Internship Program (Soft Skill Based) at the end of I semester.
3. Students are expected to submit all the assignments and appear for all weekly quizzes for their continuous assessment.
4. Students must attend "Additional Classes" conducted by the faculty for clearing the doubts and discussing other academic issues, as per need.
5. For each student, it is compulsory to appear in two Minor evaluations. The minor evaluations marks will be awarded by taking the sum of two minor evaluation marks. First two units will be covered under Minor I evaluation and next two units i.e. unit 3 and unit 4 will be covered under Minor II evaluation.
6. Make-up evaluation will be conducted only for those students who could not appear in I & II minors due to some valid/bonafide reason and who have taken prior permission from the Class Coordinators & HoD. Full syllabus will be covered under Make-up evaluation.
7. Exam fees will be deposited during Registration but it does not mean that the students are eligible to appear in the major evaluations unless the requirements specified in the ordinance of MITS-DU are fulfilled.
8. Pre-Result Review (Major Evaluations): In case of any discrepancies, the students may apply for review.
9. Grade Moderation: Statistical system of grading (relative grading) will be implemented for the award of grades (Except the M.E./ M.Tech Programmes);
10. Summer Semester is an optional semester, to be conducted at the end of each year to complete the backlog courses of preceding semesters evaluations and to makeup/improve the CGPA only if candidate has failed to score minimum CGPA of 5.0.
11. The students whose results are not declared/not eligible for year promotion are required to provisionally register with the undertaking that if they fail, their provisional registration may be treated as cancelled. Attendance during the period of provisional registration will be counted for fulfilling attendance requirements.
