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Expression of Interest (EOI) document for EMPANELMENT of Vendor Firms / Agencies for providing operational Catering Services in Mess of Hostels (Boys/Girls)

MITS-DU Gwalior invites expression of interest [EOI] for empanelment of firms/ agencies having relevant experience in providing operational catering services for running the hostel mess in the MITS-DU.

A. Background of MITS-DU:

Madhav Institute of Technology and Science, Deemed University (MITS-DU) Gwalior is a premier educational institute for B.Tech., B.Arch., M.Tech., M.C.A., M.B.A., M.U.P. & Ph.D. At present about 600 students who are staying in 04 (Four) Hostels. Each hostel has a "Mess Committee" of the residing students and hostel administration, which is authorized to regulate the mess related activities on a day-to-day basis. The hostel's administration includes a "Chief Warden", "Warden" and Vice chancellor Nominee for operation of catering services of mess contract and supervision of other related work. Generally, the strength of the residents in each of the hostel remains around 50 to 230 students (Maximum) during the academic year. However, during the vacations the strength of the students may reduce substantially or it may be closed. (Refer Academic Calendar).

B. Scope of Work:

The empanelled 'catering service provider' is expected to provide the following services:

1. Cooking and Serving Meals which includes the following in each hostel:
 - a. Morning Breakfast
 - b. Lunch
 - c. Evening Breakfast
 - d. Dinner
2. Procurement of Raw Material, Cooking Utensils (Thalis, Glasses, Bowls, Spoons etc) on self-expenditure.
3. It may be noted that if the cooking fuel connections are provided then outside cooking fuel such as Gas cylinders will not be allowed. If a PNG gas connection is provided, the vendor should be willing to accept it.
4. Managing and Control of Stocks and Inventories.
5. Cleaning of Utensils, Serving Counter, Kitchen, Cooking, Dining and Auxiliary areas.
6. Security of Kitchen Equipment's Utensils, and other related items inside the kitchen, and Mess premises.
7. Maintenance of Equipment in Kitchen, Dining and Mess Premises.
8. Deployment and Supervision of required manpower for the above-mentioned tasks. It can be noted from the above points that Operational Catering Services shall not Include Preparation of Mess Menu and any Policy matter related to running of the Mess. All decisions regarding the mess menu and policy matters will be made solely by the concerned Mess Committee or Hostel Warden as nominated by the competent authority.

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C. General Terms and Conditions:

1. The 'Catering service provider' shall provide two Meals (Lunch and Dinner) along with Morning and Evening Breakfast per day. Each meal will be served over a period of 90 to 150 minutes. The mess committee/ warden will decide the timings for each meal on different days. The Mess committee/ warden may revise the timing over the year as per academic and other activities. The Mess Committee/ warden will inform the catering service provider about the changes in the timing well in advance.
2. The Mess Committee/ warden shall provide Mess Menu to the catering service provider, which shall usually be fixed for a period of one month, though the Mess Committee/ warden reserves the right to change the menu more frequently. The Mess Committee/ warden shall communicate any change in the menu in writing, adequately in advance, to the catering service provider.
3. The Catering Service Provider Shall procure all the Raw Material and Food Articles as may be required for the Mess Menu. The wholesome Food Articles to be procured must be of Standard Brand/ Quality available in Market and with consultation to Mess Committee/ warden.
4. Catering Service provider shall ensure standard quality of Fresh Vegetables and Dairy Products from the market. The catering service provider shall not be allowed to store fresh vegetables for more than 01 (one day); however, the storage of Dairy products is not allowed in any case.
5. The catering service provider shall ensure that a sufficient stock of Raw Material and Food Articles is stored for consumption for a minimum period of 15 (fifteen) days. The mess Committee/ warden shall have the right to check the quality of Raw Materials, Food Articles and Vegetables from time to time. In the event the quality of items procured found is **NOT SATISFACTORY**, the Mess Committee/Warden/ Chief Warden is empowered to penalize the catering service provider and can recommend the termination of catering services to the Vice Chancellor.
6. The Mess Committee /Warden/ Chief Warden is authorized to impose an appropriate fine/ penalty on the catering service provider in case of sub-standard quality of food items, malpractice, lack of hygiene or violation of any of the condition of the contract.
7. The mess premises comprising of Kitchen, Dining Hall, Furniture, and storage Area will be provided by the MITS-DU. The MITS-DU will also provide the deep fridge water cooler and running water for cleaning purpose. However, kitchen equipment/ appliances, cleaning/ washing materials/ tools and manpower to properly maintain this infrastructure shall be arranged by the catering service provider at his/her own cost.
8. **The catering service provider would be charged as per the MITS-DU Norms for the:**
 - a. **Rent of Kitchen and Storage Area@ 100/-per month per students.**
 - b. **Electricity Charges for the kitchen and storage area as per actual (if applicable).**
 - c. **Water charges for the kitchen and Storage area as per actual (if applicable).**
 - d. **Cooking Fuel piped Natural Gas (PNG) charges as per actual (Billing Cycle 15 day) +LMC +Security to be made by catering service provider. (If provided by MITS-DU).**
9. The Mess shall normally be functional throughout the academic year. However, some of the mess may be closed during the vacation at the discretion of the MITS-DU during the academic session the mess will not be allowed to be closed on any day, including Sunday and other holiday, for any reason whatsoever.

10. **As it is cooperative Mess hence no relaxation in tender fee, Security Deposit, Earnest Money and in rates is permitted.**

11. The catering service provider shall ensure that sufficient manpower, on his pay roll, is deployed for preparation and catering service of each meal including cleaning, washing, and overall upkeeps of mess assets and premises. A representative distribution of the minimum manpower required for a hostel of about 50-200 residents is outlined below:

**It is recommended to have Professional qualification/competency certificate of head cook presented prior receiving the work order*

The attendance of the mess workers shall be checked from time to time and in case of deficiency in deployment of manpower, appropriate penalties may be imposed by the Mess Committee/ Warden/ Chief Warden.

12. The catering service provider shall pay not less than what is provided under the labour law of MP Govt to workers engaged by him for the work. The catering service provider shall be required to comply with all Statutory norms including the provision of Minimum wages and working norms. The Mess worker shall not work for more than over 12 hours in any situation. However, the hours of work in a day shall not exceed 08 hours.
13. Security check/ Verification of credentials are to be undertaken by the catering service provider before deployment of personnel in hostel Mess. **The catering service provider and personal (Manpower) deployed should not have any criminal or judicial case pending and/or ongoing against them.** In case the status changes during the period of empanelment, such an event must be brought to the notice of Warden/ Sr Warden/ Chief Warden. Security pass/ Identity card will be provided to each worker deployed by the catering service provider. All workers need to carry their pass while coming in /signing out of their duties.
14. The catering service provider will not be allowed to use Electricity as Cooking Fuel. However, the use of Toasters, Refrigerators, Geysers, Mixer Grinder, Microwave ovens and other electrical equipment's for cutting/ grinding are allowed. The catering service provider may also use other electrical cooking appliances after obtaining prior permission of the Warden/ Chief Warden in writing. The service provider must bring their own fridge for their daily uses.
15. All staff deployed by the catering service provider, needs to be in proper & neat uniform.
16. The catering service provider at any cost will not engage **Child Labour** in the MITS-DU premises.
17. The contract is non-transferable and Sub-letting of the contract is **Not allowed** under any circumstances.
18. The deployed staff apart from neat uniforms must also wear hand gloves, serving caps and aprons during the serving time of breakfast, lunch, and dinner. Severe Action would be imposed on the catering service provider if found violating the above.

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19. The workers employed by the catering service provider shall be a uniformed and named batch, which would be provided by the catering service provider at their own cost. The workers are not employees of the MITS-DU and shall not act detrimental to the interest of the MITS-DU. Catering service providers shall have to follow the security regulations of the MITS-DU.
20. The Contractor shall be solely responsible to meet and comply with all legal requirements with respect to the food items prepared in the mess of hostel of MITS-DU, with respect to raw material and ingredients incorporated therein and shall be exclusively responsible for any infraction of the provisions of any applicable law regarding the preparation, storage and sale of food. The agency shall ensure compliance of various Laws/Acts passed by Central, States, Municipal and local governmental agencies or authorities including but not limited to the following and their re-enactments/ amendments/ modifications:
- (i) The Payment of Wages Act 1936
 - (ii) The Employees Provident Fund Act, 1952
 - (iii) The Factory Act, 1948
 - (iv) The Contract Labour (R&A) Act, 1970
 - (v) Workmen's Compensation Act
 - (vi) The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965
 - (vii) The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972
 - (viii) The Employees State Insurance Act, 1948
 - (ix) The Employment of Children Act, 1938
 - (x) Minimum Wages Act, 1948
 - (xi) Prevention of Food Adulteration Act
 - (xii) The Essential Commodities Act
 - (xiii) Migrant Labour Act
 - (xiv) Weights and Measures Act
 - (xv) Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) Act

D. Eligibility for Empanelment:

1. The applicant should be in catering business for last 03 (Three) years as on date 10.07.2026
2. The catering service provider should have valid documents such as:
 - a. Firms/Agencies Registration Numbers
 - b. Food safety license issued M.P. Govt
 - c. PAN card number
 - d. GST Numbers (Applicable as per Govt. of India Norms)
 - e. Proof of income tax clearance Certificate/ ITR for last three years
3. Experience of having successfully run the catering services during the last 03 years ending 10.07.2026 in Educational Institutions of the Government/ Autonomous Bodies/ Universities and Institutes of National Importance having not less than 200 persons on its dining strength is mandatory.
4. The catering service provider's financial turn-over (Average) in catering services during the last 3 (Three) years 2023-24, 2024-25 and 2025-2026 should not be less than Rs. 50 Lakh. A supporting document duly certified by chartered Accountants should be submitted.

5. The catering service provider's performance for each work completed in the last 3 years and in hand should be certified by the relevant issuing Authority.
6. The cost of EOI document will be Rs. 2360/- (Rs two thousand three hundred and sixty only) including GST in the form of DD/Banker's Cheque (non-refundable) in favour of "Vice Chancellor, MITS-DU self-finance", Payable at Gwalior. The EOI (application) form can be downloaded from the MITS-DU Website or purchased from the office.
7. The catering service provider shall deposit EMD (interest free) of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rs. One Lakh only) by account payee demand draft/ Banker's cheque from any of the commercial bank in an acceptable form drawn in favour of the "Vice Chancellor, MITS-DU self-finance", payable at Gwalior with the EOI document. EMD will not carry any interest from the part of the MITS-DU and will be refunded to the empanelled catering service provider after acceptance of the contract or after deposit of the security money/performance security.
8. If The cooking fuel connections are provided, then security deposit and LMC charges as per actual will also be required to deposit in form of account payee Demand Draft/ Banker's cheque / from any of the commercial bank in an acceptable form drawn in favour of "Vice Chancellor, MITS-DU self-finance", payable at Gwalior.
9. **Security deposit Rs 5,00,000/- (Rs Five lakh only), will not carry any interest from the part of the MITS-DU and will be refunded to the empanelled catering service provider after expiry of 30 days beyond the contract period. Security deposit may be in the form of demand draft/ Banker's cheque in favour of "Vice Chancellor, MITS-DU self-finance", payable at Gwalior. This security money to be deposited before the issue of work order.**

E. Procedure for Empanelment

1. The farm/ Agencies willing to be shortlisted as a catering service provider are requested to submit their tender in the enclosed format with all the attachments and the relevant document so as to reach the **Vice chancellor, MITS-DU, Gwalior** on or before **02:00 PM on 10.07.2026**. Application reaching after the above deadline or not in the proper format shall be rejected summarily.
2. **The Vice Chancellor or representative of the Vice Chancellor has a right to empanel the technically qualified vendors on L1 rates and reserves the right to distribute the work among the empanel vendors accordingly.**
3. The selected agencies shall be empanelled initially for a period of 01(one year)/ semester wise. This period may be further extended at the end of the empanelled period at the discretion of the MITS-DU; subject to satisfactory service report from students & hostel administration and mutual agreement to another subsequent 01 (one year).
4. The MITS-DU reserves the right to inter-rotate the catering operation of various messes after 06 months, however the Rate contract will be valid for two years.
5. The MITS-DU reserves the right to reject any or all applications with or without assigning any reason whatsoever.

F. Award and termination of contract

1. The committee will select one or more vendors from the empanelled agencies for awarding of the contract for providing the operational catering services to their residents. Based on the recommendation of the committee, a final decision shall be made by the Vice Chancellor, MITS-DU.

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2. The contract shall be normally for a total period of 01 (One) year and extendable for another subsequent year at the discretion of the Competent Authority.
3. The contract may be terminated with or without giving any reason by either party by giving one month's notice to the other party.

G. Terms & Conditions of Payments

1. MITS-DU will pay at the approved rate which will be inclusive of GST payable to the catering service provider subject to TDS deduction as per the Government of India norms.
2. The catering service provider is supposed to quote rates in financial bid. Lowest Rate will be finalised for empanelment.
3. The catering service provider shall submit bills for each month to the warden/ chief warden office for further processing of payment.
4. The approved rate shall be in force for the entire period of empanelment and shall not be enhanced under any circumstances.

H. Important Notes:

1. The MITS-DU reserve the right to:
 - a. Amend the scope and value of the contract.
 - b. Amend the rate of contract.
 - c. Award any of the Hostels to any empanelled vendor agencies.
2. For any of the above actions, the MITS-DU shall neither be liable to pay any damages nor be under any obligation to inform the vendor of the ground for the same.
3. Effort on the part of the agencies or it's agent to exercise influence or to pressurise the MITS-DU for contract shall result in rejection of the application. Canvassing of any kind is strictly prohibited
4. The catering service provider should indemnify any loss or damage to MITS-DU arising out of the actions of the worker engage in the premises and also out of the statutory obligation(s) of the contractor.

I. Arbitration:

1. This has been mutually agreed between the MITS-DU and empanelled agencies/ vendors that any dispute arising out of this agreement shall be referred for "Arbitration" to the Vice Chancellor, MITS-DU, Gwalior and his decision shall be binding on the empanelled agencies/ vendors. The empanelled agencies/ vendors shall not raise any question of competence of the Vice Chancellor, MITS-DU, Gwalior, to act as sole arbitrator.
2. During the pendency of the arbitration proceeding and currency of contract, the Contractor shall not be entitled to suspend the work / service to which the dispute relates on account of the arbitration and payment to the contractor shall continue to be made in terms of the contract. Arbitration proceedings will be held at Gwalior only.
3. The arbitration would be conducted and governed by and under the provisions of Arbitration Act, 1996. Any legal dispute will be subject to jurisdiction of civil court of Gwalior (MP) and no other court shall have the jurisdiction.

J. The catering service provider will be fined in case of violation of the following rules:

1. Unavailability of complaint register on the counter/ discouraging the complaint would lead to a fine of Rs 1000/- on the catering service provider.

2. Any complaints of the insects/ stones/ other foreign object found in any meal would invite a fine of Rs 10,000/- or one day mess bill on the catering service provider
3. Three (03) or more complaints of unclean utensils in a day would lead to a fine of Rs 5000/- on a catering service provider.
4. Oil once used should not be reused. If reuse of oil is found, a penalty of a minimum of Rs.5,000/- will be imposed.
5. If the mess committee/ warden agreed that a certain meal was not cooked properly then a fine of Rs 2000/- would be imposed on the catering service provider.
6. If the mess committee/ warden agreed that a certain meal was not having good quality then a fine of Rs 10000/- or one/ two days mess bill, would be imposed on the catering service provider.
7. If food for any meal is over within the mess timing and waiting time is more than 20 minutes, including shortage of any item, then a fine of Rs 5000/- would be imposed on the catering service provider. Indicated Mess timings are as below:
 - a. Morning Breakfast with tea (Time: 07:00 AM to 09:30 AM)
 - b. Lunch (Time: 01:00 PM to 02:30 PM)
 - c. Evening Breakfast with tea (Time: 05:00 PM to 07:00 PM)
 - d. Dinner (Time: 07:30 PM to 09:30 PM)
8. Any change in menu without permission of the mess committee/ warden would result in a fine of Rs 1000/- on the catering service provider.
9. A Fine of any discrepancy (personal hygiene of workers, kitchen area, dining area etc.) would lead to a fine of Rs 5000/- or one day mess bill on the catering service provider.
10. Violation of any rules/ order of MITS-DU may fine of Rs 5000/- or one/ two days mess bill will be imposed on the catering service provider.
11. If the Contractor does not vacate the allotted space after the expiry of the Contract period or after one month of notice period of termination of Contract, the Contractor is liable to pay a daily penal rent of a minimum of Rs.5,000/- in addition to the other charges as applicable.
12. For any rules stated in the agreement:
 - i. First violation of the rule implies fine as per the rule.
 - ii. Second valuation of the same rule in the same calendar month will attract double the initial amount of fine for the catering service provider.
 - iii. All subsequent violations of the same rule would invite five times the initial amount of fine.
13. As and when the mess committee/ warden proposes a fine, it will inform the representative of the catering service provider or Mess manager and a fine will be imposed with consent of the mess committee/ warden.
14. The Mess committee/ warden/ chief warden/ vice chancellor reserves the right to review the penalty/fine imposed or terminate the tender.
