Brief Description of the Activity:	<p>An in-house workshop on "Question Paper Analysis" was organized by the Centre for Artificial Intelligence (AI) MITS Gwalior, dated 21.09.2023 for the faculty members of Centre for AI. The training module was conducted with the intent to equip the internal faculty members of the department with the process to be followed in the question paper analysis. The contents delivered during the workshop are described briefly as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The program started with the welcome of the participants by Dr. Anshika Srivastava.• During the session Dr. Vibha Tiwari discussed the overview of the question paper analysis. She also highlighted the importance of proper course outcome (CO) mapping and the use of appropriate Bloom's level while designing the question paper.• Dr. Anshika Srivastava discussed the diverse issues associated with question paper analysis and also suggested effective measures to avoid such issues.• During the session, Dr. Rajni Ranjan Singh Makwana emphasized on the important points to be considered during question paper analysis including CO coverage, Bloom's level and difficulty level. He also suggested to consider these points for question paper analysis to be carried out in future.• At the end of the session, the queries of participants were also addressed. Dr. Sunil Shukla presented the vote of thanks for the event. <p>In order to analyze the knowledge of faculty members before the commencement of the workshop, a task of question paper analysis of previous examinations was assigned to the faculty for the given subjects. In this way, the participants connected each subject to their own thoughts and provided a more thorough analysis of the content. At the end of the workshop, they submitted the detailed analysis in the required format. The session concluded with a quiz related to question paper analysis. In addition, the feedback responses were taken by the participants.</p>

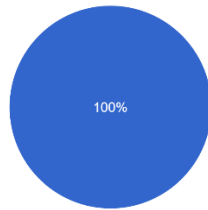
How would you rate the overall quality of the workshop conducted on Question Paper Analysis

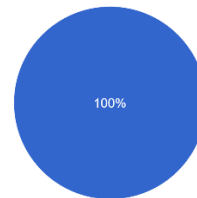
