importance in their careers.


11. Prof. G. Bhadoriya informed the students about Swayam/NPTEL platform and its courses.

The faculty members of the department, after that, shared their responsibilities with the students. Each of the faculty motivated the students to enhance their skills at MITS.


The meeting ended with vote of thanks by Dr. Abhilash Shukla.


