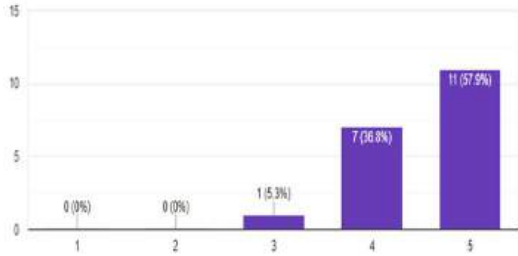

Q3. How would you rate your overall experience?

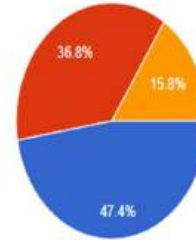

Which round did you enjoy the most?

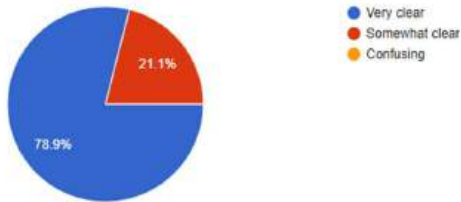

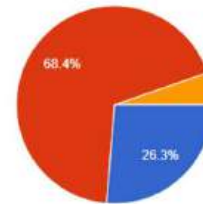

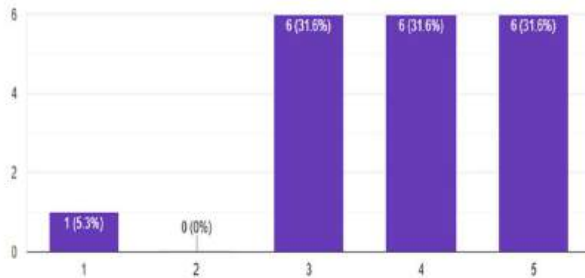
