Few teachers found a lack of books in the departmental library	Procurement of New books is in pipeline for department library so that Faculty can access it.

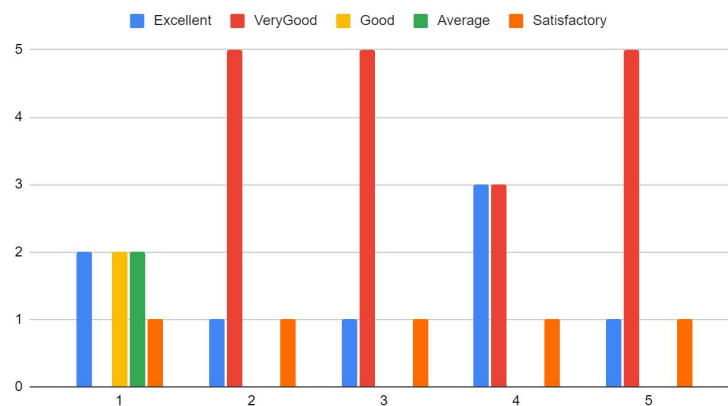

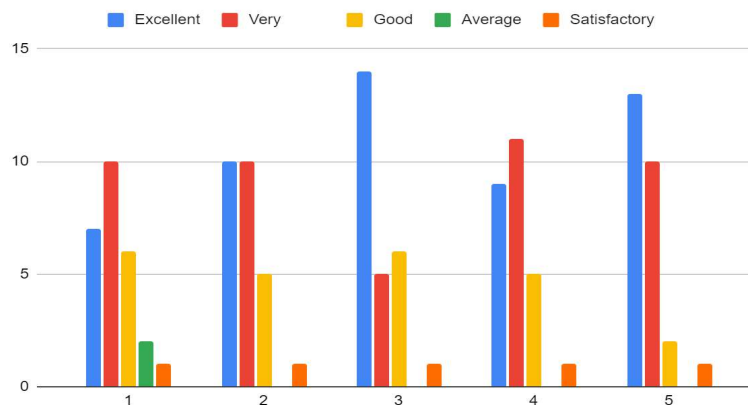

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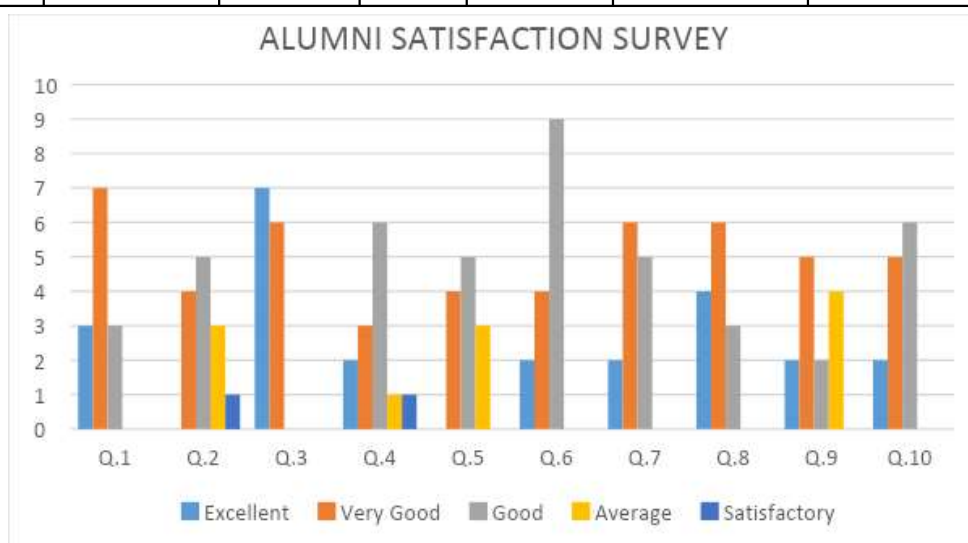
