Examination Hall Rules & Regulations for Students

Before Entering the Hall

1. Students must carry their ID card and show it when asked by the invigilator.
2. Students should reach the exam hall at least 15–30 minutes before the scheduled time.
3. Bags, books, notes, mobile phones, smartwatches, calculators (unless permitted), and any electronic devices are strictly prohibited.
4. Students must check their allotted seat number and sit accordingly.

During the Examination

5. Students should maintain complete silence in the examination hall.
6. Students must write only with permitted stationery (pens, pencils, erasers, etc.); borrowing from others is not allowed.
7. Students must not talk, exchange materials, or make gestures/signals to others.
8. Any form of unfair means or malpractice (cheating, copying, impersonation, use of gadgets) will lead to cancellation of the exam and disciplinary action.
9. Students may ask doubts only related to the question paper printing errors (if any), not about solving questions.
10. Use of abusive/objectable language or drawing irrelevant matter in the answer book is strictly prohibited.

Answer Sheet Rules

11. Write your roll number, subject, and other required details clearly on the answer sheet. Do not write your name.
12. Do not write anything on the question paper or on your desk/walls.
13. Rough work should be done only in the space provided in the answer sheet or last page.
14. Do not tear or remove any page from the answer booklet.
