



## Code of Ethics for Research

### Preamble

The Research & Developments activities are an integral part of academics in the Institution at undergraduate, post graduate and Ph.D. level. The faculty members are actively engaged in the Research activities through collaborative and Innovative research. The Institute is committed to ensure the Research Policy Framework Document issued by AICTE and UGC Regulation dated 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2018.

The Institute has developed an ecosystem to promote the professional values and ethics for Research and Development activities through a well-defined Research Policy under the monitoring and supervision of Research Committee, Research Advisory Committee, committee for Professional values and Ethics to ensure following objectives notified by UGC vide University Grants Commission Notification For Promotion Of Academic Integrity and Prevention of Plagiarism In Higher Educational Institutions Regulations, dated 23<sup>rd</sup> July, 2018:

- 1.To create awareness about responsible conduct of research, thesis, dissertation, promotion of academic integrity and prevention of misconduct including plagiarism in academic writing among student, faculty, researcher and staff.
- 2 To establish institutional mechanism through education and training to facilitate responsible conduct of research, thesis, dissertation, promotion of academic integrity and deterrence from plagiarism.
3. To develop systems to detect plagiarism and to set up mechanisms to prevent plagiarism and punish a student, faculty, researcher or staff committing the act of plagiarism.

The draft of the 'National Policy on Academic Ethics' is uploaded on Institute MOODLE so that all students, faculty and staff can read and accept it.

### Code of Ethics for Research

All students, faculty, researcher and staff required to ensure:

- proper acknowledgement of source
- permission of the author wherever necessary
- credit to concerning person wherever required
- use of Turnitin (plagiarism detection tools) for detection of plagiarism
- registration on Vidwan portal and other international researcher's Registry systems



- instructions of Departmental Academic Integrity Panel (DAIP)
- to communicate the results of their work to the society
- not to make exaggerated or false claims
- no any direct or indirect bias or discrimination against any individual or Group
- no any unacceptable forms of data manipulation or representation of false data/result
- that the outcome of research must not make any harm individual or society in any form
- the guidelines circulated through Draft National Policy on Academic Ethics, UGC Regulation 2018.
- use and sharing of equipment and facilities with other students and research scholars as and when required
- the adherence to code of Conducts of Institute as notified on Institute website.

## Plagiarism Policy

As per UGC (University Grants Commission) Notification for Promotion of Academic Integrity and Prevention of Plagiarism in Higher Educational Institutions dated 23rd July, 2018, Institute has implemented plagiarism policy to establish ethical values among students and faculty in 2018-19.

The plagiarism check is mandatory for all project reports/P.G. dissertations/ Ph.D. thesis/ papers communicated by the faculty and students to journals and conferences through Turnitin software available in the Institute. At each department, one faculty member has been designated as "Turnitin Administrator" to create awareness, to train others and to handle issues, if any. In compliance to UGC Guidelines, a Departmental Academic Integrity Panel (DAIP) was constituted in year 2018-2019. In addition, Institutional Academic Integrity Panel (IAIP) was also constituted which will consider the submissions/ recommendations of DAIP. As per norms, in research and other documents up to 15-20% overall similarity is permitted as acceptable (using turnitin plagiarism check software) provided that the highest similarity percentage from any one source is not greater than 4-6%. In case of self-plagiarism, the permissible percentage may be slightly higher, say at about 7-10%.


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

The IAIP will facilitate


- I. Training of students, faculty, researcher and staff for using plagiarism detection tools and reference management tools.

The composition of the IAIP as suggested in the Gazette notification is as follows:


1. Chairman - Pro-VC/Dean/Senior Academician of the HEI.
