

**A Report on SIP 2020 conducted online from 11/May/2021 through 29/May/2021**

The year SIP-II Soft Skills was conducted in online mode from 10<sup>th</sup> May through 29<sup>th</sup> May 2021. Following is a report of the proceeding in a nut shell:

- A total of 1114 students were registered via data from MIS for the Internship out of which 1062 students participated in the same, whereas 1045 students cleared the internship and 69 students could not clear the same.
- A total of 07 modules were administered this time and 04 faculties from the Department of Humanities, 01 each from Civil and Mechanical Engineering, 02 each from CSE and MBA were the facilitators.
- Each module was planned to be run on two day and was administered alike.
- The modules were Time Management and Ethics, Interpersonal Commutation, Attitude, Leadership, Problem Solving and Creativity, Groups and Teams, and Self Concept.
- The modules were in mixed mode. Facilitators uploaded their video lectures along with notes and other study material on the moodle and engaged in interactive sessions on ZOOM/Googlemeet for 2-3 hours split between 10:00 AM to 05:00 PM daily. The timings were flexible and were adjusted wherever needed.
- A complete time schedule of the same was prepared and followed for convenience of both the facilitators and students. The same was communicated students in advance. All such necessary details were posted on institute website as well students were emailed personally.
- The response of students was mixed as some were eager to participate in the exercise whereas other expected that some inputs should be in offline mode. A brief analysis of students' feedback is appended.
- The only concern that was noticed were class size and better quality of audio and visuals in online mode.

#### **Day-4: INTRODUCTION TO STRESS FREE LIVING.**

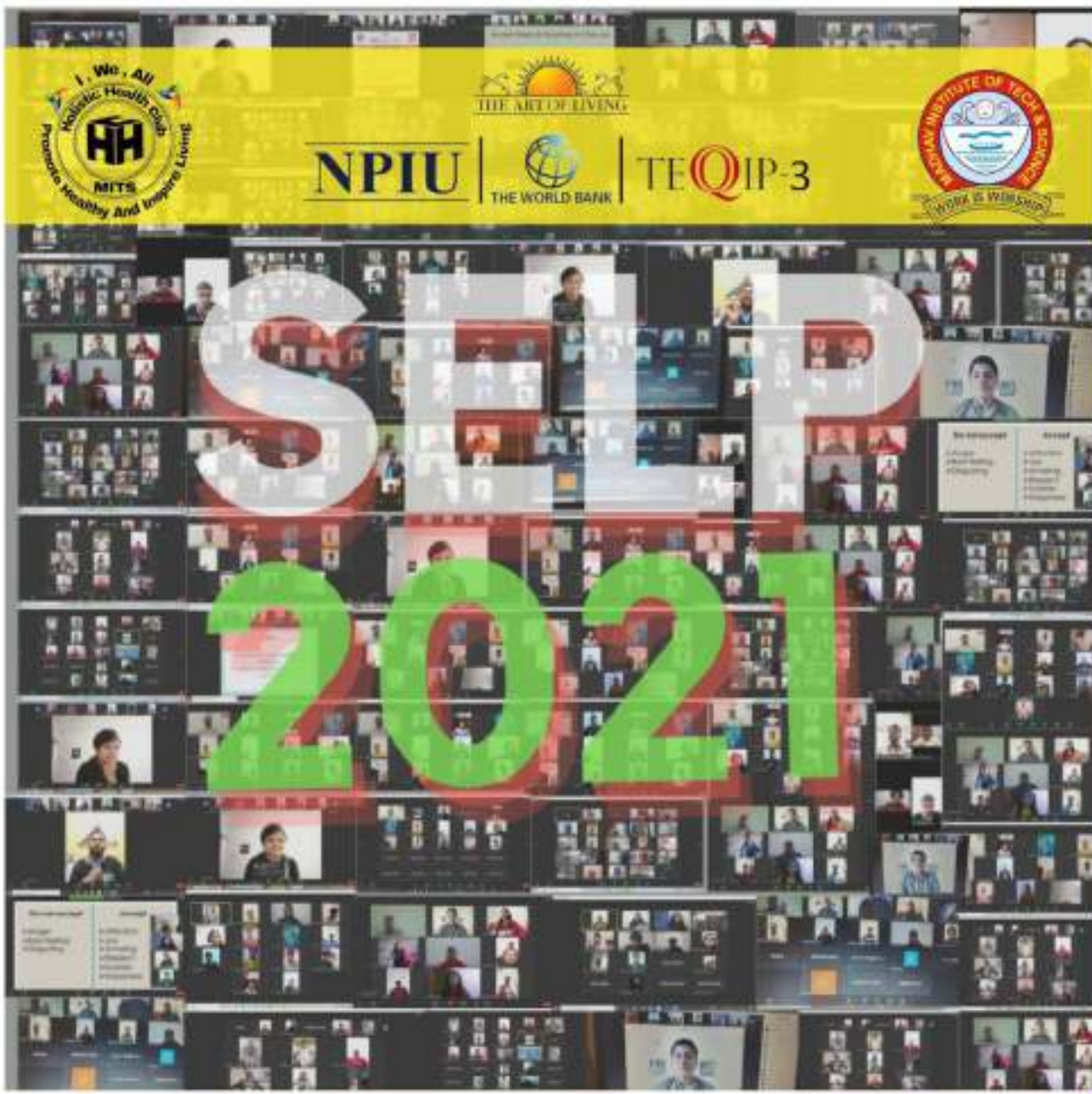

The training-workshop took place on 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2021 and 1<sup>st</sup> May, 2021 through Google meet.

### **Workshop Agenda**

The Workshop on “Architectural Professional Skills” aimed to prepare students for the forthcoming challenges in the field. Architecture academics focuses on bringing out the creativity in design but practicality and actual implementation of ideas on site is the real challenge. The workshop aimed to make students aware of the various practical aspects of professional life and the skills required to sustain the working environment in current scenarios.

### **Workshop Speaker**

The following workshop was a two day workshop and following speakers took sessions on their respective dates.

**Ar Sandeep Khatpe** held the first session of workshop on April 30, 2021. The topic of discussion was “Working online in Architecture profession”. He is a well renowned architect based in Pune, Maharashtra. With over 20 years of working experience in the architecture profession, he has also contributed in academics. He graduated from Pune University and is the founder and director of his firm Tanishq architects and planners.

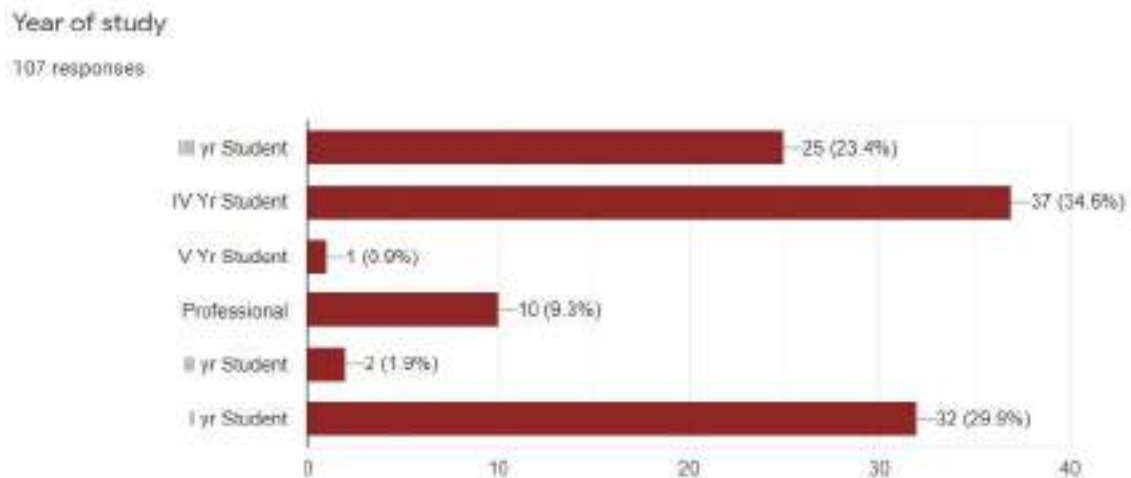
The second session of the workshop was held by **Ar Rommel Mehta**. He is a very senior architect based in Delhi with over 30 years of experience in Architecture Profession. He served as the Head of the department in Department of Landscape Architecture in SPA, Delhi and has guided in zoo designing, landscaping and infrastructure. He has extensively worked on several government landscape projects as well.

### Registration

Registration for the workshop started on 27 April '21 and ended on 29 April '21 with 107 registrations. 62% of students were from IV year and third year, 30% from I, II and III year, 10% participants were professionals.

80 and 83 participants attended the workshop on Day 1 and Day 2 respectively.

### Workshop Content

#### Day 1: Working online in Architecture profession

Ar Sandeep Khatpe discussed the challenges faced by professionals and young architects in the offices. He elaborated the process of working in online mode in architecture firms by giving the example of his own firm and how he manages his work. He shared his own experience in workspace management and how it is important to define boundaries between professional and personal space while working from home. He stressed on the dedicated time given for work. He also emphasised on maintaining the drawing skills while working on digital mode and demonstrated how real time sketching can be shared while on online meetings to explain the drawings and understanding concepts with clients, interns, laymen etc.

### **Day 2: Working Drawings**

The second day session was held by Ar Rommel Mehta who is a very experienced practitioner in the field of Architecture. He shared his experience on working scenario during covid times. He started his presentation by explaining the basics of working drawing. He listed the process of drawings in architecture and the various stages of issuing drawings. He gave an elaborate description on how to setup sheets for maintaining working drawings and explained the significance of numbering. He also shared the examples of his own works to explain the process and extent of detailing in working drawings.

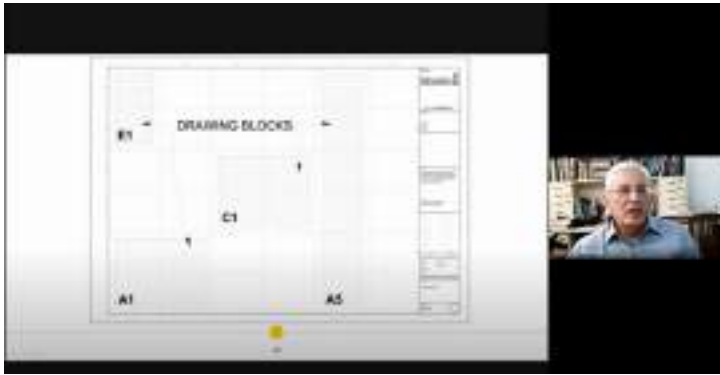

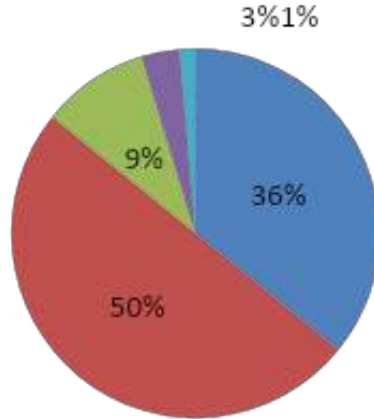

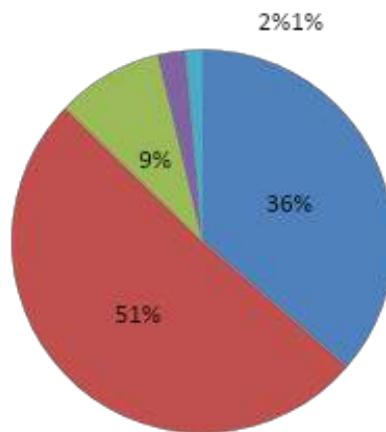

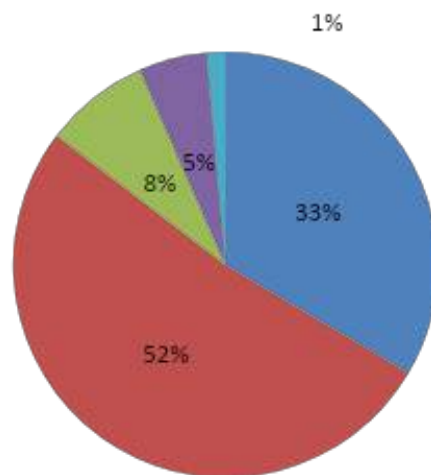

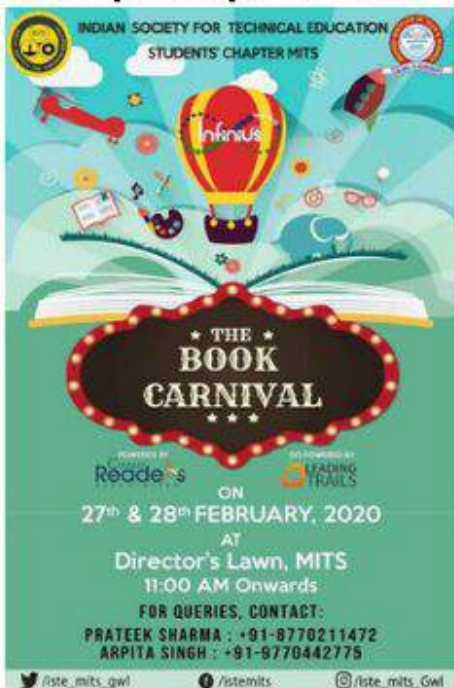
