PROGRAMME (FIP)

- ✓ An initiative of conducting "Faculty Induction Programme" for the newly recruited faculty members was taken for the first time.
- ✓ Earlier a weeklong event was planned but due to the Covid situation, only a two-day programme was conducted to apprise the new faculty about all the practices being followed in the institute.
- ✓ During this year recruitment drive was strengthened and 41 new (regular/ permanent) faculty members were appointed in two phases.
- ✓ The initiative to conduct FIP was taken for the first time. Earlier a weeklong event was planned but due to the Covid situation, only a two-day programme was conducted to apprise the new faculty about all the practices being followed in the institute.
- ✓ In the FIP, there were sessions on Teaching-learning, OBE, NEP-2020, NAAC accreditation, examination reforms, NIRF ranking, Flexible Curriculum and role of IQAC for quality assurance in the institute.
- ✓ The sessions were interactive and quiz on MOODLE was conducted after each session.
- ✓ Anonymous feedback, for each session, from the faculty, was also taken after the workshop.
- \checkmark Grades were given to participants based on their quiz performance after each session.
- ✓ The new faculty also took a pledge to serve the institute with dedication and to always uphold the rules regulations and traditions of the institute.

- 1. Context: As per Institute Perspective Plan, appointment of full time regular quality faculty is prime importance of Institute. The constant growth of faculty in all dimensions of Technical Education is an integral part of Annual Quality Assurance plan of Institute. New faculty need rigorous preparation and opportunities for continuous professional development along with academic and professional support. One of the mandates set by the Institute is the development and implementation of a high quality Faculty Induction Programme for newly recruited faculty in institution. This will help new faculty to improve their teaching and classroom management skills, adjust to the culture of higher education institutions, and better understand their professional responsibilities. The three days Faculty Induction Programme will help for the transition of new faculty into the teaching profession.
- 2. Objectives: The Faculty Induction Programme aims to help new faculty:
 - a. Understand their roles and responsibilities as faculty members
 - b. Familiarize themselves with the structure, functioning and professional expectations in institution

c. Explore pedagogical processes - curricular considerations, instructional planning, teaching methods, classroom management and transaction, use of resources and assessment

d. Recognise the importance of self-development, socio-emotional development of students and of nurturing ethics and values in higher education 3. Guidelines:

a. It is mandatory for all newly recruited regular, full time faculty members to complete the Faculty Induction Programme successfully.

- b. The Induction Programme will be conducted in Offline mode.
- c. It is envisaged as an in campus programme.

d. The pedagogy used in the Induction Programme will be participant-centred, inclusive, outcome-based, active learning with apt use of technology.

- e. The pedagogy of the Programme will be based on a combination of peer-facilitated, expert-led, and self-learning processes
 - Discussions, debate and group reflection will be the basis of in-class sessions.
 - Connecting key concepts and ideas to the everyday of the classroom will be central to the pedagogy of this programme.
 - ≻ Participants will be actively encouraged to reflect on and share their own understanding, questions, practice and experience.
 - Collaborative learning methods along with role plays and demonstration will be used.
 - Relevant internal resource persons will share their experiences.

4. Assessment: The assessment of faculty during Induction Programme will be a built-in process of continuous assessment during the sessions.

- 5. Certification: Based on Assessment process, the certificate of completion of Faculty Induction Programme will be provided after successful completion of programme.
