Eligibility

- Applicant must be in possession of Doctoral Degree (in Engineering & Technology) from a recognized institute/ university.
- The applicant should be below 45 years of age (as on the last date of application). Age relaxation can be considered for the applicants with extra-ordinary research aptitude with high quality research contribution (Journal Publications/ Patents / Product etc.)

Important Guidelines/ Instructions

- Eligible Candidates are required to submit the application form in prescribed format as per the above schedule. Candidates are required to pay application fee of Rs. 1000/- for General/OBC candidates and Rs. 500/- for SC/ST candidates through Demand Draft in favour of **Vice Chancellor MITS DU Self Finance.**
- Candidates are advised to check the eligibility before filling the application form.
- The list of shortlisted/selected candidates shall be placed on MITS-DU website <https://web.mitsgwalior.in/>
- Shortlisted candidates must bring original documents of their academic credentials, applicable scorecards, category certificate, experience certificate for verification and **No Objection Certificate (NOC)** from employer (if applicable).
- No TA/DA will be admissible for attending interview (if applicable).
- No separate call letter will be issued from the Institute for Research Proposal Presentation/Interview.

Fellowship

- Fellowship will be offered to the selected candidates as per the following:
 - Rs. 58,000/- per month, first year (consolidated amount)
 - Rs. 61,000/- per month, second year (consolidated amount)
- The fellowship is full time assignment and temporary/contractual in nature, will be offered for maximum period of two years.
- Continuation of fellowship will be subjected to the performance of the candidate/ recommendation by the periodic review committee (as per the institute norms)
- Applicant will not be entitled for availing any other fellowship/scholarship from any Govt./other agencies during the fellowship period.
- Entitlement for other Benefits:
 - Applicant may also be considered for the grant under the Innovative Research Scheme of the Institute (as per the institute norms)
